

## Bad Jurist,

Enclosed are my accounts of 3 bad jurists.

1) Joel Schwartz, Attorney at Law, of:

In December of 2013 I retained Schwartz with another business owner for \$25,000.00 to consult me on synthetic marijuana. He informed me he would tell me what substances were legal to sell and arrange chemical testing for me. In March of 2015 I was federally indicted for selling substances he told me were legal. He represented me in the criminal matter and hid from the U.S. Attorney that he was telling me and many other clients that certain kinds of synthetic marijuana were legal to sell. He pressured me to plead guilty informing me I faced only about 6 years. My Guideline sentence came back showing I faced 360-720 months in prison. When I attempted to withdraw my plea Schwartz testified he never consulted me on selling synthetic marijuana. Prior to this, in mid 2014 he set up a meeting with me and an assistant U.S. Attorney where prior to the meeting Schwartz told me to minimize information I had about his other clients, don't disclose his consultations with me on synthetic marijuana, and not to disclose how

much I had paid him. He testified in court that he never consulted me on synthetic marijuana at my plea withdrawal hearing, in opposition to overwhelming evidence. I later found out he allowed over 100 thousand dollars in cash and property to be forfeited to the DEA without contesting it after telling me he was handling the forfeitures.

Upon investigation after my sentencing to 30 years I found out that Schwartz had been accused by many clients of lying to them. His firm had been involved in knowingly representing clients with gross conflicts of interest, and in smuggling clients contraband into county jails. Schwartz engaged in conduct that resulted in ethical complaints from state prosecutor Leah Askey. Schwartz falsified documents intended to protect himself from criminal and civil liability when I filed an ineffective assistance of counsel motion against him. He also went behind my back to solicit money from my parents while I was incarcerated, telling them to give him \$25,000.00 and to not discuss it with me. He had them meet him with cash at an undisclosed area.

2) Daniel Aaron Chatham - Assistant U.S. Attorney  
For the Northern District of Iowa - Cedar Rapids.

Dan Chatham encouraged me to lie about targets of his investigations into synthetic marijuana. When I refused he encouraged other criminal defendants to lie about me. He was meeting with multiple criminal defendants who were cooperating against each other that were represented by the same defense attorney. He didn't report these conflicts to the court.

3) Linda Reade, Senior Circuit Judge  
For the Northern District of Iowa - Cedar Rapids  
Reade ignored and explained away evidence that my defense counsel acted under multiple conflicts of interest and committed criminal acts. She disregarded letters introduced into evidence from my codefendant that the prosecutor in my case asked him to lie in his testimony against me. She made several shockingly bad credibility findings against me. She found several inapplicable sentencing enhancements proper in my case to take my sentence up from a few years to over 30 years on the Guidelines chart.
