You may find this hard to believe but, the same District Attorney who began my case, who shared personal correspondences with my trial attorney, also motioned to seek the Death Penalty against me only weeks later became the TRIAL JUDGE in my case! Yes, you read that correct, the same District Attorney who charged me, later became the trial judge. This fact wasn't brought to my attention until after my trial. I mean, me as a 21 year old, I didn't know it but, I'm sure my attorney was aware of this fact.

I've enclosed a few copies of documents for your review and you'll see for yourself. As your ad says, "Together we can make a difference". I just want the truth of what happened to me to be made known to the citizens. My only hope is that you can help me to get my story and the truth about what happened to me out there. I came in here a 21 year old kid, I'm now 52 soon to be 53 and I don't deserve to die here but, without a voice that may be my fate.


Dear Mr. Lewis:


COMMONWEALTH'S NOTICE OF AGGRAVATING CIRCUMSTANCES

AND NOW, comes Richard A. Lewis, District Attorney of Dauphin County, by Todd B. Narvol, Chief Deputy District Attorney, who provides this notice to defendant and his counsel:

1. Pursuant to Rule 352 of the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, the Commonwealth hereby provides notice to the defendant that the Commonwealth intends to seek the death penalty in the above-captioned case and will submit the following aggravating circumstances during the sentencing hearing:

1. AGGRAVATING CIRCUMSTANCE #6: A killing committed in the perpetration of a felony, 42 Pa.C.S. § 9711 (d) (6); and
2. AGGRAVATING CIRCUMSTANCE #8: The offense was committed by means of torture, 42 Pa.C.S. § 9711 (d) (8).
