I am Cordell Sanders. Come May 17, 2024 I've been incarcerated for twenty years for first Degree Murder in which I received twenty years for. I have a good revelation for yall I've titled the "Get Money Scheme" which goes as follows: Pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statute 730 ILCS 5/3-6-5, any time ILDOC wants a prisoner prosecuted for a violation of any law while house in ILDOC, ILDOC must fund the prosecution. Annually, ILDOC gets around 2 Billion dollars to do what it wants with it. The Livingston County Court located in Pontiac, IL has an extensive history of charging and over charging it's mentally ill and mentally sane prisoners most who are held in Solitary Confinement at Pontiac State prison for petty crimes no matter if the crime allegations are true or not E.G. Self defense against a prison guard, assault because of extreme provocation from a prison guard, bumping into a guard, spittle while talking to a guard, stepping on a guards shoe, and other charges guys shouldn't be charged with. For indictment purposes, a Grand Jury is never convened due to costs and the fear that a grand jury wouldn't pass an indictment for such petty "crimes". Guys are indicted by information which consists of a prison "investigator" who hasn't been to college to be an investigator coming to court and swearing under oath that a crime was committed. In the event an indictment is sustained, the prisoner is usually destitute to the point where he can't hire private counsel and is then appointed a

a wholly substandard, hostile and corrupt, ineffective public Defender who is usually in collusion with the States Attorney and corrupt, and rogue judge like Judge Jennifer Bauck next. One highly inappropriate p.d. is Randle Morgan. Because of the apparent hostility from the P.D., Judge and States Attorney a small number of prisoners proceed Pro-se like I did and the vast majority of prisoners take a plea deal sentence. There exist no language in the above cited statute that require the court to return to ILDOC unused funds given to it for prosecution purposes. Prisoners with life sentences and Defacto life sentences are even charged. Check out Illinois Compiled Statute 730 ILCS 5/3-6-5. These courts are stealing from the taxpayers! If courts are required to return unused funds for prosecution, the trend of charging prisoners with frivolous cases would cease.
